- Upload an AgriLife Vendor Application (W-9) within application submission.
- Answer all of the questions thoroughly within the application.
- Prepare project plan with specific goals (schematic/layout).
- Prepare project budget plan.
- Prepare post-project maintenance plan.
- Prepare a marketing and award recognition plan.
- Be prepared to measure community involvement and impact of project and to report through the TMN VMS.
- Where appropriate, highlight partnerships established for this project and any other possible opportunities to further explore.
