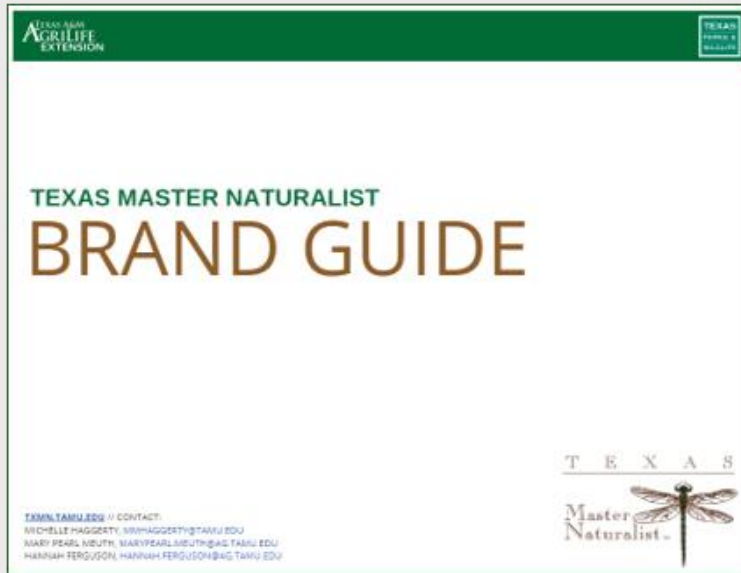

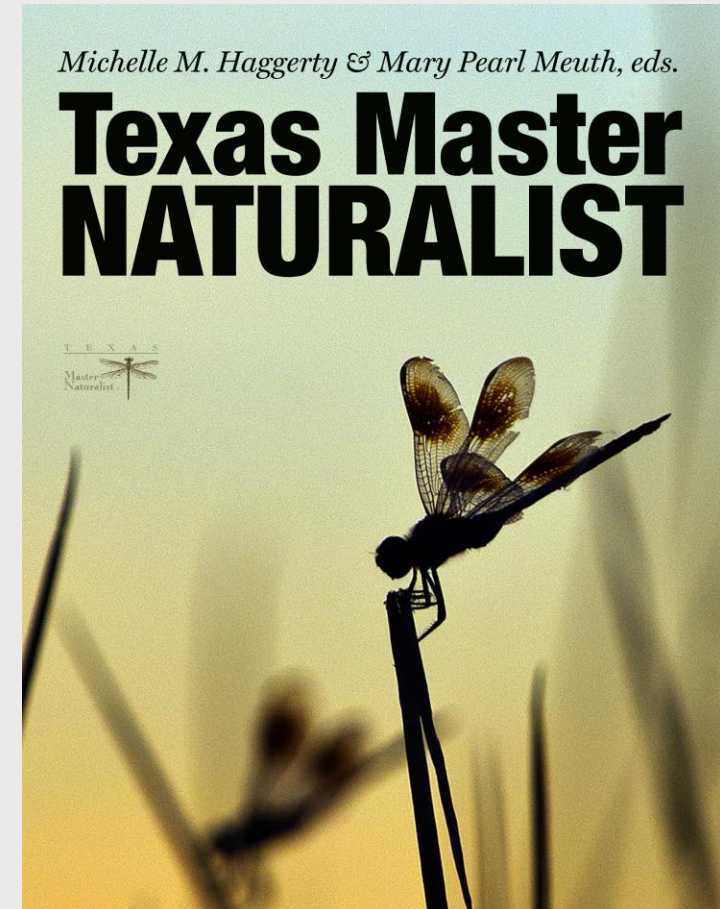
TMN Statewide Curriculum Update

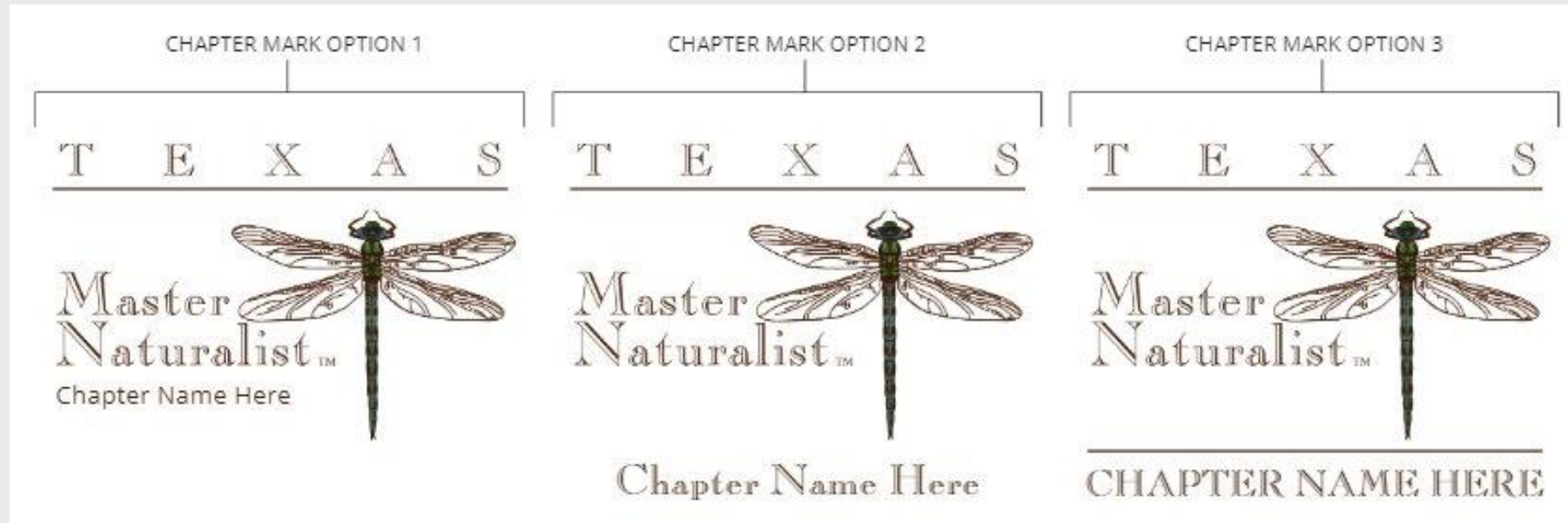
Reminders to our Membership: Using the TMN Title

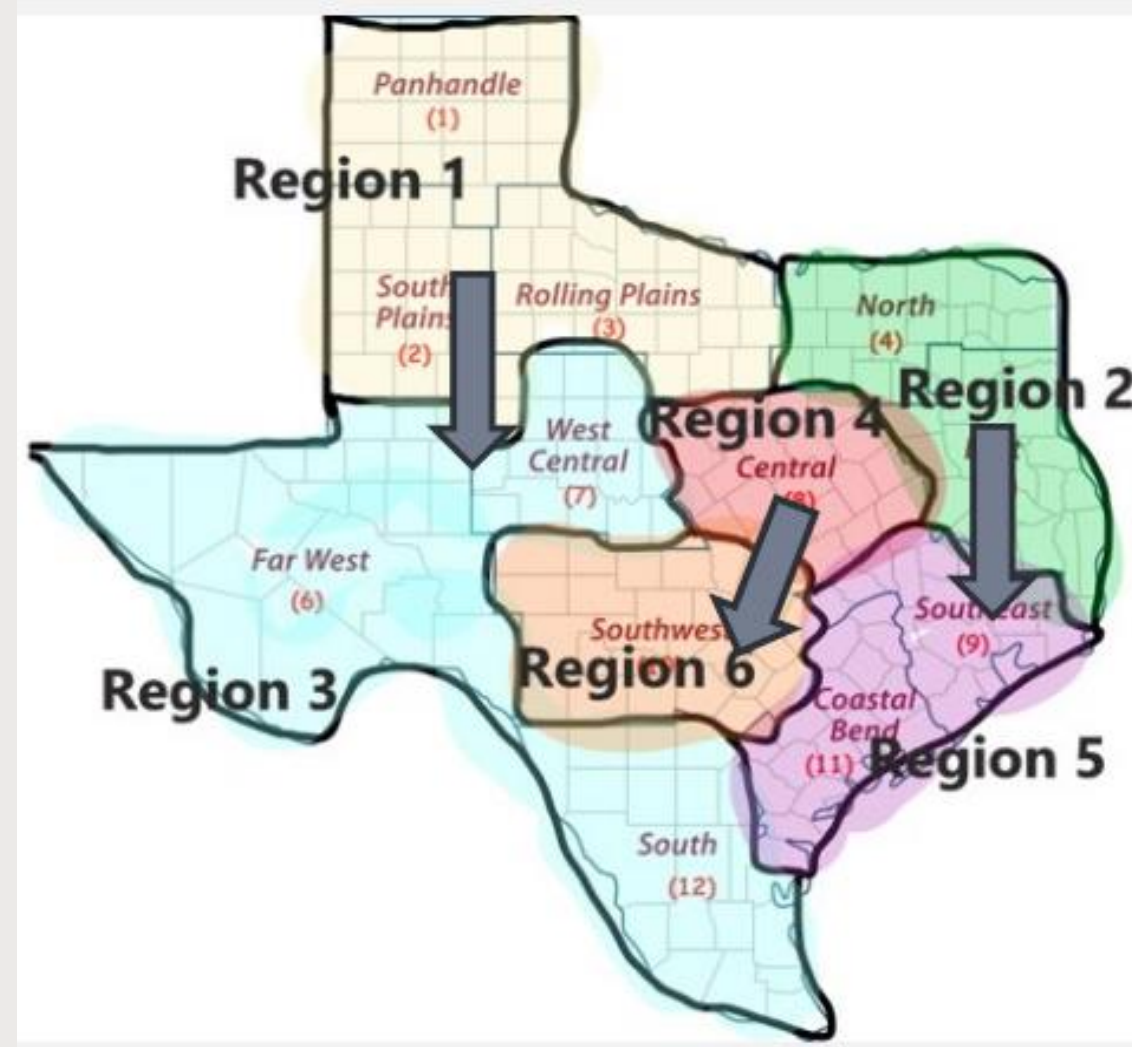

TMN VMS Updates

- **Our TMN VMS has been undergoing a re-fresh & re-build to enable updates and new features.**
- **For our TMN Volunteers:**
- Overall, no changes for the end user (TMN reporting volunteers) yet
- FAQ = Will there be a phone app? - No, however anyone can report through the browser version on their phone.
- **For Chapter TMN VMS Admins:**
- Added a Rapid Training Team to our TMN VMS Administrative Team for the conversion
- Training Moratorium lifted -- Submit requests for new local chapter Admin Trainings at the TMN VMS help desk to assist with the new year turn over where needed. (39 Trainings held this year so far)
- We anticipate QA/QC to take place in the next few months.

Improving TMN Reporting

One Simple Request (shared via a ppt slide or follow up email):

- For Chapter Meetings, AT, and Service Projects your chapter leadership provides/leads please help with providing guidance on reporting to general members present. Please help ensure they are reporting to the correct category too.

Example for your time here today:

For attending/viewing today's meeting you will report your time as follows:

Opportunity = Chapter Business

Project Category = Chapter & Program Business Admin - President's Duties

Service Description = February Presidents & Advisors meeting with the state office

Improving TMN Reporting - Logging Initial Training Classes -

Logging Initial Training & Classes for new Trainees:

- Individual Initial Training Classes should be logged for each trainee.
 - Note: It's a great way for them to get familiar with VMS and reporting.
 - Note: Their Initial Training classes info is important for inevitable transfers
 - Note: Completion of Initial Training also needs to be identified in VMS.

Be Aware of Phishing/Scam Issues

Scam upticks in the new officer year are common

Directors' names and email addresses spoofed and appear to be asking others in the chapter for information or funds.

- Gift card scam
- Bank account access
- “I need a favor” scam
- through email and/or text messages

Options:

- Let your members know that you will never ask for these things via TMN emails
- Make it your chapter practice and policy (and make it known) that you only ‘do business’ (like this) during official business meetings, never over email or text
- Put directors email list behind password protected page, or on an external share drive
- Add forms for contacting chapter & use CAPTCHA option
- Send out directors' email list to chapter members once in external email at beginning of year
- How else?

When in doubt – call the real named person "emailing/texting"!
